VI. **New Business**

Concessions – First three games grossed \$13,939.00. There is a concession meeting Thursday to sign the contract.

The Meal Deal has been reduced to 238 students. The fall fundraiser will be concessions. Not sure what the spring fundraiser will be.

Band Banquet expenses and meal ticket will be one line item.

Band Activity Fund – Meal Deal

Office Expenses – increased to cover copies and other supplies.

AJ Memorial Fund – This fund was set up to help individual kids who cannot afford their supplies.

Director's Discretionary Fund – Used for techs and equipment. Director's requested an

in-ear monitor for the soloist at \$1,600.00. Kami called TX Tour Gear and rented one for \$25.00 a week.

The budget will be tabled for a month and then be voted on by the booster membership.

Fundraising – Discussed fundraising at Freddy’s Oct. 4<sup>th</sup> and possibly Jersey Mikes or Chipotle.
