IV. Director's Reports

Belton High School – Mr. Stein – Proud of Colorguard and instructors! Currently working on auditions for next year. The Design team for fall is on the M100 website. Jazz band festival will be this Saturday at UT. Next week is UIL competition – families can attend the last 20 minutes if practice to see a run through of the UIL performance.

South Belton Middle School – April Luce – UIL Concert and Sight-Reading Contest is at Midway High school on April 18 & 19. Symphonic Band performs at 5:15 on Wednesday, April 18, and Wind Ensemble performs at 1:35 on Thursday, April 19.

Jazz band will perform at the Kiwanis Turtle Festival at Yettie Polk Park on Saturday, April 28 at 2:00PM.

All 6th & 7th grade band students will be playing their end-of-year audition in class during the week of April 30 to May 4. This is part of their semester exam, and will determine placement for next year.

Beginners will have a group rehearsal on Mon & Tues, April 30 & May 1 to prepare for their Temple College Contest performance. The performance is at TC PAC Friday, May 4 at 12:00PM. Jazz Band will perform at the Jazz-O-Rama concert May 10 at 7:00PM.

All concert bands will be performing at the Band-O-Rama on Friday, May 11 in the PAC. There is a spring trip chaperone meeting on Monday, May 14 starting at 5:30PM in the Band Hall. The spring trip is to Typhoon Texas in Pflugerville on Saturday, May 19.

Lake Belton Middle School – Mr. Dolotina – LBMA has 327 kids signed up for band next year! Audition materials have been distributed and will be performed to determine placement for next year. There are 190 band kids enrolled for 7th and 8th grade.

UIL Concert and Sight-Reading Contest is at Midway High school on April 18 & 19.

LBMS is taking three bands to contest. All concert bands will be performing at the Band-O-Rama on Friday, May 11 in the PAC.

Volunteer Coordinator – Cheryl Mortimer – Finally finished with concessions. Will talk about how to schedule shifts for next year. Kids can work for community service. Next year volunteer paperwork will be on-line.

Fundraising Coordinator – Connie Olsen – We sold 822 Nothing but Bundt cakes. Extras were sold before the concert and we made \$1,600. Schlotzsky's fundraiser will be April 18 in Belton. On May 16 we will be at Freddy's again and will make 30% of the proceeds. The goal for next year is to do one fundraiser a month except in October we will try to do 2-3 fundraisers.
