



Belton Band Booster Meeting

Monday, May 14, 2018, @6:00 PM

Prior to Meeting the minutes and reports were distributed.

- I. Call to order by President, Kami Cargile
- II. The minutes of the previous meeting, April 9, 2018 were reviewed. A motion to approve was made by Angelica Fountain 2nd by Sara Crosswhite.
- III. **Treasurer's Report** – Christie Bledsoe – Report included in hand out – Christie is in Ecuador.

IV. **Director's Reports**

Belton High School – Mr. Stein – Concert and sight-reading contests all did very well. Band O Rama went great, venue was good, will use same format next year. Spring training begins next week – hours for summer band is out. Daniel Reberger will be our new percussion director for next year. He is from Indiana and currently teaching in Frisco.

South Belton Middle School – Chris Pulley – Linda Grant will be the liaison next year for SBMS. Ensemble placements for next year were publicized this morning in the band hall. Students performed their end of year audition the week of April 30th.

Both Symphonic Band and Wind Ensemble competed in the UIL concert and sight-reading contest at Midway HS and earned sweepstakes ratings.

Beginner's Ensemble competed at the TC contest on Friday, May 4th and walked away with First Division Superior ratings from all three judges.

Spring trip to Typhoon Texas Waterpark in Pflugerville is Saturday, May 19th.

End-of-Year Awards Ceremony is Friday, May 25 in the SBMS gym - 6th grade starts at 8:30, 7th grade at 10:00 and 8th grade at 1:15.

Lake Belton Middle School – Kim Flowers – Alyssa Kimmel will be the liaison next year for LBMS.

Three bands participated in UIL Concert and sight-reading contest at Midway HS on April 18th & 19th. The Concert band received a II/excellent rating on stage and a 1/superior rating in sight-reading. The Symphonic band received a 1/superior division rating in both concert and sight-reading. The Wind Ensemble received a 1/superior division rating in both concert performance and sight-reading. This is the 13th consecutive year the the LBMS Wind Ensemble has received a Sweepstakes Award.

LBMS beginning band participated in the TC Band Festival on May 4th. They received 1st division ratings from all 3 judges. All LBMS students participated in Band O Rama last Friday. Students travel to Fiesta Texas on May 31st.

Summer Band will be August 1, 2, 3, 6, and 7th. Tiger camp performance is August 13th.

North Belton Middle School – Dr. Kline – Tracy cook will be the liaison for NBMS next year. NBMS bands participated in UIL Concert and sight-reading at Midway HS, Symphonic band received II division in stage and a 1 division in sight-reading. Wind Ensemble received 1 division in stage and II division in sight-reading. We are having a breakfast for 8th grade band members and an ice cream party for beginning band members. Participated in Band O Rama and will be going to Fiesta Texas May 31st. Summer band is August 1, 2, 3, 6, and 7th. Tiger performance is August 13th. We are wrapping up the year and this is a calendar building month.

V. Committee Reports –

Spirit Ware Coordinator – Brandy Hart – Busy month – 1,000.00 raised at Band O Rama and with concert shirts. This year student under uniforms will be handled internally and not through Cochran, Blair and Potts.

Fundraiser Coordinator – Connie Olsen – We have one more Wed. night fundraiser at Freddy's – we get 30% of all sales. Thanks for helping with the spaghetti super Friday night. Discussed having a spaghetti dinner during summer band with what was left over.

The meal deal will change to \$120.00 for next year.

VI. Old Business – Vote on 2018-19 Budget – Motion to approve Duane Gochoel 2nd by Kaylenn Henderson – vote 23 approved and 0 (zero) opposed.

Mr. Stein questioned the amount of the discretionary fund for next year and the significant difference. It was discussed that in 2016 we made \$59,000 in concessions and was able to give \$38,000 to directors. In 2018, \$41,000 was made in concessions and the plan is to give \$28,000 to directors for next year. Also, the new high school will open fall of 2021 and the current booster club would like to put back \$8,300 a year for three years to be able to give \$25,000 to the new high school to help start their band booster club.

Will check with other booster clubs and see what they are doing to set up booster clubs for the new high school.

VII. New Business – 4th of July Parade – Duane Gochoel and Michelle Masters will work on water and shelter.

DCI July 19th – Brandy Hart - Will need volunteers for certain positions; computer, concessions, ushers, parking lot attendants etc. 60-70 volunteers are needed for shift work. Will wear volunteer or M100 shirts. Event is from 10:00am – 10:00pm – show starts at 5:00pm.
