



Belton Band Booster Meeting

Monday, November 12, 2018, @6:30 PM

Prior to Meeting the minutes and reports were distributed.

- I. Call to order by Vice President, Director of Operations, Sara Crosswhite
- II. The minutes of the previous meeting, October 15, 2018, were reviewed. A motion to approve was made by Christy France, 2nd by Angelique Fountain.
- III. **Treasurer's Report** – Stacie Kline – Stacie reported that the main revenue for October was concessions. Additional revenues included photo fundraiser, spirit wear sales, and other miscellaneous items. October was a high-expense month due to meal deal and the donation to the middle schools. Our bottom line for October shows a deficit of almost \$9,500, but year-to-date is still positive at \$3,100.

IV. Directors' Reports

Belton High School – Ed Stein – Mr. Stein offered a little history on the Area competition and the history of the program. Work on next year's show has already begun. All region band is coming up on December 1st and 8th. Around 95-100 students are registered. Mr. Stein took time to thank the boosters for all of their hard work during marching season.

South Belton Middle School – Linda – A record number of students earned spots in All-Region Band. Around 100 kids gathered for a band social at Spare Time. The jazz band performed at the VA Hospital in Temple. The band will perform December 1st at Christmas on the Chisholm Trail in downtown Belton. The Symphonic Band and Wind Ensemble combined to perform at the annual Vet Assembly. Wind Ensemble will travel to several middle schools as a part of the annual holiday tour. The holiday concert will be on December 7th at the PAC at 7 PM.

Lake Belton Middle School – Kim Flowers – The Middle School All-Region Band Clinic was held at BHS on November 10th. There were 30 students from LBMS that were chosen to participate. The LBMS Christmas Concert is scheduled for November 27th at the PAC at 7 PM. The band will march at the Temple Christmas Parade on December 3rd. The Wind Ensemble will travel to a couple of middle schools on December 14th to play Christmas tunes and encourage band participation.

North Belton Middle School – Stacie Klein – As an NBMS parent, Stacie spoke about upcoming events due to the absence of a North Belton representative. Stacie reported that the band social is scheduled for November 16th from 6-8. The winter concert is scheduled for

Friday, November 30th at the PAC at 7 PM. According to the band's Facebook post, 15 students from NBMS made the all-region band.

V. **Committee Reports –**

Uniform Manager – Sharon Cobb – Sharon reported that we are finished fitting students for formal wear, and she thanked parents for all the help. Formals have been returned from the dry cleaners and are being organized for concert season. Sharon mentioned wanting to minimize dry cleaning expenses possibly by shopping around, asking for donations, or offering a sponsorship. Uniforms will be available to be checked out for senior pictures.

Hospitality – Connie Olson – Kids continue to be fed. Connie discussed recent meals and any problems associated with the vendors, and she spoke about future meals.

Sprit Wear Coordinator –Bob Hart –Senior shirts sales went well, and the students seemed to love them. There may be a second opportunity to order portraits depending on the demand. This year's ornaments have been received. Cookies will be provided to the students during the Christmas concert. Cookie donations are being requested.

Chaperone Coordinator – Angelique Fountain – Angelique thanked all chaperones for the help so far this year. Contacting chaperones in the event of an away playoff game was discussed.
